1 5	Section 1716. Any person in this state who shall steal any
1 6	horse, jackass, jennet, mule, cow, hog, or implement of husbandry,
1 7	as defined in Section 1-125 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes
1 8	shall be guilty of a felony and upon conviction shall be punished by
1 9	confinement in the State Penitentiary for a term of not less than
2 0	three (3) five (5) years, nor more than ten (10) fifteen (15) years;
2 1	and any person in this state who shall steal any dog, sheep, or
2 2	goat, shall be guilty of a felony and upon conviction therefor shall
2 3	be punished by confinement in the State Penitentiary for a term not
2 4	less than six (6) months, nor more than three (3) years, or <u>and</u> by a

1	fine in an amount that is equal to three times the value of animals
2	and machinery that were stolen but not more than Five Hundred
3	Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00), or by both such fine and
4	imprisonment Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000.00).
5	The word "horse" as used in this section includes all animals of the
6	equine species and the word "cow" includes all animals of bovine
7	species.
8	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
