AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to voter registration; providing procedures for voter registration on election days; providing for establishment of identity and residency; requiring oath under certain circumstances; providing for casting of a provisional ballot by such registrants; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

- SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7-115.4 of Title 26, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- A. A person who is eligible to register to vote, but is not registered, may register on the days set forth in Section 14-115.4 of Title 26 of the Oklahoma Statutes by appearing in person at the office of the county election board and completing a voter registration application, making written oath, and providing proof of identity as set forth in Section 7-114 of Title 26 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The method of registration set forth in this section shall be in addition to any other method of registration

provided by law. If the identification presented does not contain the person's current address in the precinct, the person may be requested to present another form of proof of identity that shows the person's name and address in the precinct.

- B. The oath required pursuant to subsection A of this section shall be attached to the voter registration application, and the information contained in the oath shall be recorded on the voter registration records of the person registering to vote.
- C. A person applying to register to vote as provided in this section shall be permitted to vote on the day of registration if the county election board makes a determination that the person is qualified to become a registered voter.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
