SENATE BILL 33

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to firearms; allowing certain law enforcement agency employees to carry a firearm in the scope of employment; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1289.31 of Title 21, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any law enforcement agency which employs noncommissioned civilian crime scene technicians or crime scene investigators may authorize such employees who have a valid Oklahoma concealed carry handgun permit, to carry such licensed weapon while acting in the scope of their employment. The director of the employing agency must grant written authorization, which the noncommissioned technician or investigator must keep on his or her person at all times while carrying the weapon, along with the appropriate valid concealed carry permit and photo identification.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.

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
