SENATE BILL 447

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to court clerks; requiring court clerks to set certain hearings; providing exception; authorizing court to reschedule certain hearings; requiring notice; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 35.2 of Title 12, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

In any case or proceeding in the district courts, the court clerk at the time of the filing of a petition or information shall set the date and time for hearing of all motions other than expedited or emergency motions, and provide notice to all parties. The district court judge may reschedule the date and time set by the court clerk, and provide notice of the new date and time to all parties.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
