HOUSE BILL 1030

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1290.26, as last amended by Section 18, Chapter 15, O.S.L. 2013 (21 O.S. Supp. 2014, Section 1290.26), which relates to the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act; modifying certain residency provision; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1290.26, as last amended by Section 18, Chapter 15, O.S.L. 2013 (21 O.S. Supp. 2014, Section 1290.26), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1290.26

RECIPROCAL AGREEMENT AUTHORITY

The State of Oklahoma hereby recognizes any valid concealed or unconcealed carry weapons permit or license issued by another state, or if the state is a nonpermitting carry state, this state shall reciprocate under the permitting law of that state.

A. Any person entering this state in possession of a firearm authorized for concealed or unconcealed carry upon the authority and license of another state is authorized to continue to carry a

1 concealed or unconcealed firearm and license in this state; provided
2 the license from the other state remains valid. The firearm must
3 either be carried unconcealed or concealed from detection and view,
4 and upon coming in contact with any peace officer of this state, the
5 person must disclose the fact that he or she is in possession of a
6 concealed or unconcealed firearm pursuant to a valid concealed or
7 unconcealed carry weapons permit or license issued in another state.

8 B. Any person entering this state in possession of a firearm
9 authorized for concealed carry upon the authority of a state that is
10 a nonpermitted carry state and the person is in compliance with the
11 Oklahoma Self-Defense Act, the person is authorized to carry a
12 concealed firearm in this state. The firearm must be carried fully
13 concealed from detection and view, and upon coming in contact with
14 any peace officer of this state, the person must disclose the fact
15 that he or she is in possession of a concealed firearm pursuant to
16 the nonpermitting laws of the state in which he or she is a legal
17 resident. The person shall present proper identification by a valid
18 photo ID as proof that he or she is a legal resident in such a non-
19 permitting state. The Department of Public Safety shall keep a
20 current list of non-permitting states for law enforcement officers
21 to confirm that a state is nonpermitting.

22 C. Any person who is twenty-one (21) years of age or older
23 having a valid firearm license from another state ~~may~~ shall apply
24 for a handgun license in this state ~~immediately~~ within one (1) year

1 upon establishing a residence in this state. The handgun license
2 issued from another state shall cease to be valid in Oklahoma once
3 the person has established residency in this state and has been
4 issued a handgun license pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma
5 Self-Defense Act.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
