An Act relating to initiative and referendum; amending 34 O.S. 2011, Sections 1 and 2, which relate to referendum and initiative petition forms; modifying time limit for filing; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
