HOUSE BILL 1566

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to Medicaid; directing the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to implement pilot program to evaluate managed care model for provision of services; requiring completion of implementation by certain date; directing Authority to seek certain waivers; requiring Authority to promulgate certain rules; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1011.13 of Title 56, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority is directed to develop and implement a pilot program to evaluate the potential use of a patient-centered, integrated managed care system for the provision of services provided under the Oklahoma Medicaid Program. The pilot program shall begin no later than January 1, 2017.

B. The Authority shall submit proposals for approval and seek amendments or waivers of applicable federal laws and regulations

1 from the United States Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services as
2 necessary to implement the provisions of this section.

3 C. The Authority shall promulgate and adopt rules to enforce
4 the provisions of this section.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.

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
