**Research Analysis**

As introduced, the measure modifies the urban renewal plan notification process by striking from the definition of Blighted Area, the following:

- Population overcrowding;
- Inadequate parcel size;
- Arrested economic development;
- Faulty layout in relation to size;
- Adequacy;
- Accessibility or usefulness;
- Diversity of ownership;
- Defective or unusual conditions of title; and
- Constitutes an economic or social liability.

The measure also modifies the urban renewal public hearing notification process by requiring:

- Publication at least three (3) times not less than thirty (30) days prior to the date of a public meeting; and
- Posting not less than fifteen (15) public notice signs, each having sixty-four (64) square feet of display area for thirty (30) consecutive days on the most-traveled roads in the area affected by the proposed plan.
