Research Analysis

HB 1076 directs the Department of Corrections to pursue rehabilitation opportunities through the implementation of the "Oklahoma Cedar Control Project". Selected inmates are to be used to harvest Eastern Red Cedar and other cedar species deemed as invasive on public and private land. Creates the "Hope for Tomorrow Revolving Fund" to consist of monies donated to the Department. Provides that costs for services performed on private lands are to be reimbursed to the Department.
