## **Research Analysis**

HB 1343 requires certain contractors to be treated as independent contractors if the organization the contractor works for is one that operates a digital platform to facilitate the services provided by the contractor to individuals. A contractor would be treated as an independent contractor if all or most of their pay is directly related to services performed and not the number of hours worked, and the services performed are governed by a contract between the operator of the platform and the contractor, that contractor is considered an independent contractor.
