Research Analysis

Introduced HB1371 prohibit the state from claiming governmental interest in any litigation brought under the Oklahoma Religious Freedom Act that would require a person to participate in or provide services for any marriage ceremony, celebration or related activity against the person's religious belief. The measure defines person, as it relates the Oklahoma Religious Freedom Act, as a natural or juridical person, including but not limited to unincorporated nonprofit corporations.
