Research Analysis

HB 1391 modifies the Oklahoma Self Defense Act by requiring the completion of a firearms safety and training refresher course. The measure increases the fee for renewal from \$85 to \$90 with \$5 of the fee remitted to CLEET to be credited to the Firearms Instructors Revolving Fund. The measure allows for the use of an online firearms safety and training course to satisfy the training requirements for an SDA permit. The measure clarifies that Oklahoma recognizes valid carry permits issued by another state to nonresidents of Oklahoma only and that any license from another state is not to be recognized when the holder establishes residency in Oklahoma.

Fiscal Analysis

According to officials with the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, HB1391 as currently written will require the OSBI Accounting Unit to modify programs and create methods to track the receipt of \$90 handgun license renewal fees (\$180 for 10 year renewals) and periodically transfer \$5 of the fee to CLEET's Firearms Instructors Revolving Fund.

In CY 2014 5-year renewal fees remitted with applications totaled \$835,890 and 10-year renewal fees totaled \$1,170,620. Combined CY 2014 renewal fees remitted with applications totaled \$2,006,510.
