**Research Analysis**

HB 1460 provides that the Legislature preempts the entire field of legislation relating to knives and that no municipality or political subdivision may enact any ordinance or regulation regarding knives. The measure allows public or private schools to create policies regulating the possession of knives by students on school property or in a vehicle used by the school for transportation.
