Fiscal Analysis

HB 1579, as introduced, would require elections for the office of county sheriff to be conducted on a nonpartisan basis, beginning with the 2016 election cycle. As the State Election Board may add a nonpartisan Sheriff race to partisan ballots on a primary election date, the only cost associated with this measure is that relating to printing a nonpartisan ballot for all Independent voters. The Election Board estimates a maximum cost of \$70,000.
