Research Analysis

HB 1614 creates the Oklahoma Transportation Network Company Services Act which establishes a regulatory scheme to license companies that use a digital network or software application service to connect passengers to transportation network services. The measure requires transportation network companies to be permitted by the Oklahoma Corporation Commission for an annual fee of \$5,000. The measure requires transportation network companies and transportation network company drivers to carry certain automobile liability insurance. The measure establishes safety protocols regarding transportation network company drivers.
