## **Fiscal Analysis**

FA1 for HB 1622, which relates to the Oklahoma School Testing Program Act, contains provisions for elimination of the existing testing system in grades three through eight in addition to administration of a new testing system in those grades beginning with the 2016-2017 school year, elimination of existing end-of-instruction tests and administration of newly-developed tests beginning with the 2016-2017 school year for new high school students, and consultation with the State Regents for Higher Education and the State Board of Career and Technology Education regarding recommendations for new assessment requirements. Elimination of existing tests and development of new tests may modify testing expenditures, but new tests would require the agency to request vendor bids- any cost increases or decreases from existing testing expenditures would depend on such bids.
