Research Analysis

HB 1748, as introduced, requires state agencies to report the amount of federal funds received and to rank the funds according to the agencies reliance on them. The bill also requires the report contain a description of:

- actions required of, or prohibited by, the agency as a condition for receiving the funds;
- actions required of, or prohibited by, an individual or business as a result of the use of federal funds; and
- the cost incurred to comply with federal requirements associated with the funds, ranked according to cost.

The measure directs all state entities to provide reporting, both in writing and on the entity's website describing all federal funds under the control of the entity. Certain prioritization and conditions associated with the federal funds are to be included in the reporting..
