Research Analysis

The SAHB for HB 1823 directs the State Board of Education to seek certification from the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education regarding the Board's recommended revisions to the A-F report card calculation metrics. The State Regents are to provide the Board with a description of the certification process and results.

The measure asks the State Board of Education to re-evaluate the A-F report card system and provide a report to the Governor, Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate by December 31, 2015.

Fiscal Analysis

ESA to EHB 1823 which relates to reports for the Oklahoma School Testing Program, requires the State Board of Education to study and may recommend revisions to the Legislature to the calculation metrics of all components of the school report cards. The Board will seek certification from the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education. The measure is not anticipated to have a significant impact on state funds.
