## **Research Analysis**

HB 1965 prohibits a person from operating a motor vehicle while texting, emailing or using instant messaging while the vehicle is in motion. The measure establishes a fine of \$250 for a first offense and \$500 for second and subsequent offenses. The bill provides that billing records for a cellular device may be admissible in any proceeding to determine if a violation occurred.
