**Research Analysis**

The CS for HB 2180 provides several exemptions to the thirty credit hours per semester requirement for OHLAP participants.

The measure amends the OHLAP program by requiring participating students to enroll in a minimum of thirty credit hours per academic semester. Additionally, the measure expands eligibility through the eleventh grade and to the age of eighteen.
