Fiscal Analysis

Senate amendment to HB 2180 which relates to the Oklahoma Higher Learning Access Program strikes the title, enacting clause and bill and inserts language which includes requiring completion of 24 earned credit hours per academic year with specified exceptions. A student not qualifying for an exception will retain eligibility under certain circumstances. In addition, eligibility is expanded through the eleventh grade or between the ages of 13 and 16.

Currently, 27% of these students are enrolled in 23 hours or under per academic year, which is approximately 5,112 students. State Regents' staff provide that with the exceptions, probationary period and other changes to the measure, there is expected to be no significant fiscal impact.
