## **Research Analysis**

HB2261, as introduced, modifies the definition of *American Indian tribe, American Indian* and *authentic American Indian arts and crafts* as it relates to the American Indian Arts and Crafts Act of 1974. The measure defines *American Indian tribe* as any Indian tribe federally recognized by the Bureau of Indian Affairs and defines *American Indian* as a citizen or enrolled member of an American Indian tribe. The measure also adds performing arts and literature to the list of authentic art that is enforced by the act.
