**Fiscal Analysis**

No fiscal impact or impact to the RFP process; there's no change in scope to the RFP development and so no change in cost to produce an RFP. It will have an impact in terms of immediate savings after implementation. We announced on Nov 30<sup>th</sup> and in stakeholder meetings: *To achieve meaningful results under this model, it is essential that members residing in nursing facilities\* ultimately be enrolled; delaying their enrollment by two years already has reduced the model's potential short term impact.* \*\*

\*now with PCS the term nursing facilities is interchanged with advantage waiver and state plan personal care

\*\*The short term impact refers to savings to the state as well as improved health outcomes.
