**Research Analysis**

The measure modifies the process by which a municipality awards licenses or permits for the operation of cable television services. The measure changes the scope of a municipal authority from cable television services to video services. The measure limits the amount of the rental payment to not exceed five percent of the annual gross revenues derived by the video services provider from the provision of video services within the municipality.
