Research Analysis

The PCS to HB 2368 prohibits a person from intentionally or knowingly operating an unmanned aircraft over the private agricultural property of another for malicious purposes which are detrimental to the character or economic interests of the property owner. The measure exempts the governmental entities, persons under contract with a governmental entity, law enforcement, or persons under contract with law enforcement, or persons who have prior written consent of the property owner or lessee of the property. Punishment for violation is a misdemeanor subject to a \$500 fine, up to 1 year in the county jail or both fine and imprisonment.
