**Research Analysis**

The CS for **HB 2428** creates the Child Welfare Provider Inclusion Act of 2016. The measure provides that no state agency may refuse to contract or enter into an agreement with a child welfare service provider because the provider declines to provide or refer for a child welfare service that conflicts with the provider's religious beliefs or moral convictions which are expressed in the mission statement of the provider.
