Research Analysis

HB 2444, as introduced, increases from \$10,000 to \$100,000 the maximum daily penalty for a violation of rules or regulations relating to pipeline safety or to the Hazardous Liquid Transportation System Safety Act. The measure also increases from \$500,000 to \$1,000,000 the maximum total penalty for a series of such violations.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 2444 increases the daily maximum pipeline safety violation fees from ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) to one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00). It also increases the maximum civil penalty from five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00) to one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00). This increases revenue for the Corporation Commission and the exact amount is contingent upon how many violators pay the penalty.

HB 2444 also increases the daily maximum hazardous liquid transportation violation fees from ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) to one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00). It also increases the maximum civil penalty from five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00) to one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00). This also increases revenue for the Corporation Commission and the exact amount is contingent upon how many violators pay the penalty.
