**Research Analysis**

The SA to HB 2503 removes from the list of entities to sunset in 2012 the Oklahoma Liquefied Petroleum Gas Research, Marketing and Safety Commission. The measure is clean-up language that removes references to and repeals sections related to the Oklahoma Wheat Utilization, Research and Market Development Commission. The measure transfers a balance in the commission's revolving fund to the state's general revenue fund.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The Senate amendment on HB 2503 transfers any unexpended balance by November 1, 2016 in the revolving fund (200 Fund) from the Wheat Commission to the General Revenue Fund. The current balance as of 4/29/2016 is \$0. Therefore, there is zero fiscal impact to the state.
