## **Research Analysis**

The bill creates the Medicaid Rebalancing Act of 2020. It limits Medicaid coverage to 133% of the federal poverty level for nondisabled children and pregnant women when the current maintenance-of-effort expires in 2019. It creates a new individual Insure Oklahoma commercial insurance plan for adults between the ages of 19 and 64 whose incomes do not exceed 133% of the federal poverty level. The plan will include an incentive account and will be suspended if the federal matching rate for the plan drops below 90%.
