**Research Analysis**

The bill extends the Oklahoma Medicaid Program to students up to age 26 for those enrolled in an accredited technology center school, university or college in the state.

**Fiscal Analysis**

According to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority, the CS for HB 2803 would allow students enrolled in colleges, universities and technology centers to remain in the Insure Oklahoma program until they reach 26 years of age. The state share of the cost is \$1,300 per enrollee per year using existing funds from current tax allocation to OHCA.
