HB 2835 removes the age restriction on the use of cannabidiol to allow a person of any age who is participating in a clinical trial for the treatment of severe forms of epilepsy, spasticity due to multiple sclerosis or due to paraplegia, intractable nausea and vomiting, appetite stimulation with chronic wasting diseases.
