Research Analysis

The PCS to HB 2864 places the Oklahoma Department of Public Safety, the Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control, and the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation under the direction of the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Commission. The seven-member Commission is to select a superintendent to coordinate the law enforcement activities of the agencies within the Oklahoma Department of Law Enforcement. The superintendent is to formulate and implement a unified law enforcement strategy for law enforcement activities with annual and long-term measurable goals and objectives to achieve greater public safety in the state.
