Research Analysis

HB 2869 prohibits persons and property owners from establishing certain policies or rules concerning concealed or unconcealed firearms on any property designated by a city, town, county, or state governmental authority as a park, recreational area, or fairgrounds. The carrying of a firearm may be prohibited on any property designated by a city, town, county, or state governmental authority as a park, recreational area, or fairgrounds during any events on the property. The measure provides immunity from liability for any person, property owner, tenant, employer, place of worship or business entity that does not prohibit person from carrying a firearm.
