## **Research Analysis**

HB 2929, as introduced, prohibits an employer from firing or discriminating against an employee for inquiring about or discussing the wages of an employee, for discussing or inquiring about a wage claim, starting any proceedings related to this act, or testifying in such a proceeding. The measure also increases the minimum fine for willful wage discrimination based on gender from \$25 to \$50, and the maximum fine from \$100 to \$200.
