Research Analysis

The Conference Committee Substitute to HB 3098 allows any person to lawfully carry a firearm unconcealed in this state if the person is twenty-one years of age or older and not otherwise precluded from carrying a firearm. Persons wishing to carry concealed must obtain an SDA license. The measure allows persons making application for an SDA license to submit applications to any sheriff office in the state. The measure authorizes reciprocity for persons who have a license in another state or are citizens of a non-permitted state to carry unconcealed.
