Research Analysis

HB3162, as introduced, modifies the appointing authority for attorney commissioners of the Judicial Nominating Commission and terminates the appointment of all attorney members currently serving on January 1, 2017. To replace the vacated appointments, six new attorney members will be appointed in the following manner by February 1, 2017:

- two members, one from Congressional District (CD) 1 one from CD 2 appointed by the President Pro Tempore for an initial two year term;
- two members, from CD 3 and one from CD 4 appointed by the Speaker of the House, for an initial four year term; and
- two members, one from CD 5 appointed by the President Pro Tempore and one from CD 6 appointed by the Speaker of the House, for an initial 6 year term.
