## Fiscal Analysis

The authorization of \$125 million in obligations by the Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority (OCIA) may require appropriation amounts adequate to make timely lease payments, an amount that will depend on the structure of the bond issuance and current market conditions. Using market data as of the morning of February 24, 2016 with an average interest rate of 3.06 percent, a 20-year issue of \$125 million in obligations might result in annual lease payments, excluding any administrative fees, of approximately \$8.4 million.
