Research Analysis

HJR 1012 is a legislative referendum for a state question that would amend the State Constitution to guarantee farming and ranching practices.

The Senate amendment added language to clarify that nothing in the bill should be interpreted to modify any provision of common law or statutes relating to dominance of mineral interests, easements, and rights of way. The second amendment clarifies that nothing in the section can be interpreted to modify any statute or ordinance enacted prior to December 31, 2014.
