Research Analysis

HJR 1020, as introduced, puts to a vote of the people a proposal to call a Constitutional Convention to convene July 10, 2017 for the purpose of amending the current Constitution or to propose a new state Constitution. The measure also: provides for the selection of delegates and creates a Constitutional Convention Commission to oversee the selection of delegates; requires the convention to adjourn sine die no later than June 30, 2018; provides that expenses of the convention would be the responsibility of the Legislature, and provides that delegates would be subject to the same rules and laws to which legislators are subject.

Fiscal Analysis

Prior estimates provided by officials with the House totaled the daily cost of holding the Constitutional Convention at approximately \$12,500, excluding any potential overtime and Session only staff. The daily estimate does not include any potential need for updated computer updates or modification. The total cost will be dependent on the number of days subject to travel and per diem reimbursement.
