**Research Analysis**

HJR1042, as introduced, proposes a constitutional amendment to modify the process in which judicial vacancies are filled. The measure would require the Judicial Nominating Commission to submit to the Governor a list and ranking of all qualified nominees for a vacant office. Currently, the commission submits a list of three names with no particular classification.
