HJR 1062 puts to a vote of the people an amendment to the state constitution that, if approved, would repeal Section 5 of Article II of the Oklahoma Constitution which prohibits public money or property from being used directly or indirectly for any church or system of religion. The proposal would also add a new section prohibiting the Legislature from passing laws respecting an establishment of religion.
