## **Research Analysis**

SB 1016 directs the Secretary of the State Election Board to compare the driver license or identification card record with the information contained on a voter registration application submitted electronically to ensure that they substantially match. The measure also extends statutory provisions regarding confidentiality of personal information within driver records to the information obtained by the State Election Board and requires the Board to keep a full or partial Social Security number or driver license number confidential.
