Research Analysis

The bill permits a board of education, through a majority vote, to authorize the superintendent to designate school personnel with a valid handgun license to attend an armed security guard training program or a reserve peace officer certification program developed by CLEET. Additionally, the names of school personnel who have been designated to carry a firearm must be kept confidential and will not be subject to the Oklahoma Open Records Act.

Fiscal Analysis

ESB 1036 relates to school personnel and allows a board of education of a school district to authorize the school district superintendent to designate school personnel who have been issued a handgun license to attend an armed security guard training program. Names of designated school personnel will be kept confidential and exempt from the Oklahoma Open Records Act. The measure is anticipated to have no fiscal impact of state funds.
