Research Analysis

SB 1083 amends workers' compensation insurance requirements under the Roofing Contractor Registration Act. The measure would allow an affidavit for exemption for workers' compensation insurance only for residential construction projects. All commercial projects would require all individuals performing work to be covered by workers' compensation insurance as employees of the person registered under the RCRA. Day laborers would be exempted upon proof of being covered by their temporary agency.

Finally, the bill shields a homeowner from liability for injury or death to any person who performs work under contract with someone required to be registered under RCRA and to have workers' compensation insurance on all workers on the project.
