**Fiscal Analysis**

The fourth amendment to FA1 on SB 1142 establishes a fine amount three times the maximum fine as well as in addition to the original fine in Title 29 of the OK Statutes. This fine is for people who violate any part of the Wildlife Conservation Code whilst attempting to remove feral swine.

Title 29 deals with many violations and has many fees, revenue for the Dept. of Wildlife depends on how many individuals violate this act, which violation a citizen commits, and what that fine limit is for that specific violation.
