**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute to SB 1257 creates a new crime to intentionally disseminate an image of another person who is engaged in a sexual act or whose intimate parts are exposed with the intent to harass or humiliate the person. The new crime is a misdemeanor, punishable by up to 1 year in the county jail, a fine of up to \$1,000 or both. The court may order the defendant to remove the image if the court finds it is in the power of the defendant to do so.

**Fiscal Analysis**

Persons found to violate the provisions of SB1257 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor for a first offense, and guilt of a felony for any subsequent offenses. This will come with at least one year of imprisonment and a fine of not more than \$25,000.00.
