**Research Analysis**

SB 1362 allows the Department of Public Safety to create a REAL ID compliant driver license or identification card. The measure allows an applicant for an Oklahoma driver license or identification card opt for a REAL ID compliant license or card or a noncompliant license or card. The measure establishes a new fee schedule for a REAL ID compliant license and identification card. The measure requires that every applicant for a driver license to provide the address of the principal residence to be referenced on the license.

**Fiscal Analysis**

According to officials with the Department of Public Safety, “the bill requires that \$10 from each REAL ID compliant license be deposited in the Department of Public Safety Revolving Fund.”

Additionally, “it provides that the department or motor license agent will collect \$4 to be deducted from the total collected for the license card, which will be deposited in the Department of Public Safety Revolving Fund or used for the motor license agents operating expenses, respectively.”

Finally, “the bill also calls for an increase on all DL/ID cards by \$15.00 to be deposited in the DPS revolving fund. This would generate approximately \$16,500,000 per year.”

DPS states that there will be a onetime cost of approximately \$1,685,664.00, and an annual cost of approximately \$11,376,065.00. However, the \$16,500,000 in revenue will offset those costs and bring in approximately \$5,123,935.
