Fiscal Analysis

The measure directs the Department of Transportation (ODOT) to place permanent markers upon the highways bearing the name of the individuals to be honored. 69 O.S. § 1600 provides that the costs associated with signage related to the naming of highways and bridges is to be paid by the group sponsoring or requesting the sign, except in instances of naming a highway or bridge to honor members of the armed forces who were killed in action. The individuals named in this measure are not armed forces members killed in action, therefore the cost of the signage will be paid by the sponsoring group.
