Research Analysis

The bill stipulates that the performance of an abortion by a physician will constitute unprofessional conduct and prohibits the physician from obtaining or renewing a license to practice medicine. The State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision and the State Board of Osteopathic Examiners must revoke the license of physicians performing an abortion. It modifies the definition of *abortion* to include an exception to preserve the life or health of the mother. Lastly, it stipulates that if the bill is challenged in court, the Attorney General's office must determine the amount of state or local funds that will be expended to defend the challenge.
