## **Fiscal Analysis**

The measure requires the State Board of Education to issue teaching certificates to certain out-of-state teachers, and requires those teachers to pay for and provide to the Board a current Oklahoma criminal history record check and a national criminal history record check. According to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation (OSBI), the cost of a name search and fingerprint search total \$15 and \$19, respectively, and the cost of a national criminal history check totals \$50 plus shipping fees.
